### Why should you volunteer?

The first priority of the Canadian Fossil Discovery Centre is in the field of Paleontology and related earth sciences. The Centre's purpose is to search and excavate, document, collect, preserve, research and study, provide public exhibitions, educate, and interpret fossil and geological specimens including prehistoric environments primarily from the Manitoba Escarpment as well as (including) surrounding areas and related geological formations.

The Canadian Fossil Discovery Centre (CFDC) has the largest collection of marine reptile fossils in Canada and our prized specimen is Bruce, a 43' long Mosasaur. In addition, Betsy, a 26' long plesiosaur was added to our collection in 2004. Our fossil collection grows year after year thanks to the fossil rich Manitoba Escarpment of the Pembina Hills where we own a 109 acre property. We have hardly scratched the surface! From May to September, the CFDC offers Paleo tours and dig programs to the public, to schools and to researchers. Our museum, with 14,000 square feet of gallery space is open year round.
